2024 TLR Rules and Information

Note: Words in red are changes for 2024

- ALL riders must pick-up their rider packet at sign-up BEFORE 9AM race.
- AMA Membership required.
- Moto-Tally transponders used for scoring along with course checkpoints.
- No Trials bikes.
- No tire restrictions.
- No spectator assistance allowed. RORR members will assist only if course becomes completely blocked.
- Helmets are required at all times!
- Several spectator spots within short walking distance from start area.
- Awards for all classes EXCEPT PRO will come from Saturday race results with the exception of those that qualify for the main event.
- Saturday race row assignments based on Pre-entry date and time.

VERY IMPORTANT!!!

ABSOLUTELY NO RIDING IS ALLOWED IN THE PITS OR AROUND THE PROPERTY. THIS WAS A SERIOUS PROBLEM LAST YEAR AND WILL NOT TOLERATED THIS YEAR. THIS MEANS NO RIDING TO SPECTATOR POINTS ON YOUR DIRT BIKE, PIT BIKE OR ATV. BRING YOUR BICYCLE OR WALK, THOSE ARE YOUR ONLY TWO OPTIONS.

Saturday Tough Race 1 - 9:00am

• Tough Race #1 – 1 lap, 10-mile course.

Pre entry date and time determines your start position within your class.

- Classes line up 6 riders per row.
- 1 minute between rows, and each row is time adjusted.
- TOP 120 will automatically advance to Sunday TLR Main Event, all the rest advance to Saturday afternoon LCQ at 2:30pm
- Dead engine start with both hands on helmet for all races



Saturday Tough Race Course Descriptions

• Course will be more difficult than past years, though nothing like the main event. To try and minimize bottlenecks we will start 6 riders every minute, instead of 30 like past years. Every rider will be given 2 hours to complete course. At 12pm the race is over. PRO riders, Sunday is for you.

Saturday Afternoon LCQ - 1 lap 7 mile course

- 2:30PM All unqualified riders
- 6 riders start every 30 seconds, time adjusted.
- Fasted 6 riders not qualified for Main Event start on row 1, and so on.
- Top 10 riders advance to TLR Final
- All riders will be given 90 minutes to complete course.
- At 4:00pm the race is over regardless of where you are on the course.
- 1 checkpoint will be used for scoring non finishing riders.

Tough Like RORR Sunday 9:00am

- 13 rows of 10 riders, dead engine start.
- 30 seconds between each row, NO time adjustment.
- 6 hours to complete 2 laps on a 13-mile course.
- Main Event is designed for PRO riders. Course will be significantly more difficult than previous races.
- 2nd lap will have add-in sections that are extremely difficult and meant to challenge ELITE PRO riders.
- At 3:00 race is over regardless of where you are on course.
- Numerous checkpoints will be used for scoring.
- Tracking devices will be used for TLR Main to allow spectators to follow riders and to discourage cheating.
- Cheating will not be tolerated. If found doing so you will be disqualified.
- It's the rider's responsibility to be present for cash awards.
