

2023 TLR Rules and Information, (words in red are changes for 2023)

ALL riders must pick-up their rider packet at sign-up BEFORE 9AM race, even if you are in the 11AM race

AMA Membership required

Moto-Tally transponders used for scoring along with course checkpoints No Trials bikes

No tire restrictions

No spectator assistance allowed

RORR members will assist only if course becomes completely blocked ABSOLUTELY NO RIDING IS ALLOWED IN THE PITS OR AROUND THE PROPERTY. THIS WAS A SERIOUS PROBLEM LAST YEAR AND WILL NOT TOLERATED THIS YEAR. THIS MEANS NO RIDING TO SPECTATOR POINTS ON YOUR DIRT BIKE, PIT BIKE OR ATV. BRING YOUR BICYCLE OR WALK, THOSE ARE YOUR TWO OPTIONS

Helmets are required at all times

Several spectator spots within short walking distance from start area Awards for A-B-C-40 Expert, 45+-Junior will come from Saturday race results

with the exception of those that qualify for the main event

Saturday Tough Race 1 Start Procedure

Tough Race #1 – 2 laps on a 4+ mile course

9:00 – Pro Women, B, C, Junior and Women

11:00 – Pro, A, 40 Exp and 45+

pre entry date and time determines your start

position

Classes line up 15 riders per row, 30 seconds between rows, each row is time adjusted



TOP 50 will automatically advance to Sunday TLR Main Event all the rest advance to Saturday afternoon LCQ at 2pm

Saturday Tough Race Course Descriptions

Courses are designed for the average rider. Courses will be extremely technical, but all riders should be able to navigate course. PRO riders, Sunday is for you

Saturday Afternoon LCQ

2PM – All unqualified riders

5 riders start every 30 seconds, time adjusted Fasted 5 riders not qualified for Main Event start on row 1, and so on Top 10 riders advance to TLR Final All riders will be given 90 minutes to complete course At 4:00pm the race is over regardless of where you are on the course

1 checkpoint will be used for scoring non finishing riders

Tough Like RORR Sunday 9:00

6 rows of 10 riders, dead engine start
15 seconds between each row, NO time adjustment
6 Hours to complete 2 laps on 13 mile course
Main Event is designed for PRO riders. Course will be significantly more difficult than previous races
2nd lap will have numerous add in sections specifically meant to challenge top PRO riders
At 3:00 race is over regardless of where you are on course
Numerous checkpoints will be used for scoring
Tracking devices will be used for TLR Main to allow spectators to follow riders and also to discourage cheating
Riders responsibility to be present for cash awards
Cheating will not be tolerated. If found doing so you will be DQ'ed
